The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioners have filed this criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 5 to ensure freedom and to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.6 to 9.

Learned State counsel has filed the copy of affidavit of Satish Kumar, PPS, DSP, Sub Division Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur, which is taken on record. It has been mentioned in the affidavit that respondents No.6 to 9 have stated in their statement that they have no objection over the

marriage of the petitioners and they will not interfere in the married life of the petitioners. Even the petitioners have also stated in their statement recorded with the police of P.S. Adampur, District Jalandhar that they do not require police protection of any kind at present.

In view of the above, the present petition no more survives and is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
