This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.56 dated 06.05.2020 under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Ludhiana.

This petition had come up for preliminary hearing before this Court on 05.06.2020 and while issuing notice of motion the following order was passed:-

“Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of

-pre-arrest bail to petitioners in case FIR No.56 dated 06.05.2020 under Sections 148, 307, 323 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Ms. Rashmi Attri, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and seeks time to file short reply alongwith medico-legal reports of Kulwinder Singh as well as Gurmeet Singh. Complete copy of paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 11.06.2020.

On a subsequent date of hearing i.e.11.06.2020 the following directions were issued:-

Reply on behalf of the State has been filed and the same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag it at the appropriate place and page mark it.

From the aforementioned reply, it is evident that there is no allegation against the petitioners having used any shard edged weapons.

Thus, the petitioners are directed to join investigation at the first instance on 25.06.2020 at 10.00 a.m. and cooperate therewith. In the event of their arrest, they shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to their compliance of the

conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 20.08.2020.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Harnesh Singh informs the Court that the petitioners have since joined investigation. Even the sticks used in the alleged occurrence have been recovered and the petitioners are not required for any custodial interrogation.

In view of the above petition is allowed. Order dated 11.06.2020 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
