The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioners after remaining in live-in relationship have now solemnized marriage on 30.05.2020. Petitioner No.2 was earlier married with one English Woman on 26.05.2016. He could not pull on with his wife and ultimately, got divorce from Foreign Court on 23.01.2020. Petitioners are quite matured and their live-in relationship resulted in giving birth to a son namely Samarjot Singh on 15.11.2018.

Petitioners have prayed for issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents for protecting their civil/personal rights and liberties from being invaded by the private respondents. They feel reasonable apprehension and threat perception at the

hands of the private respondents and pray that their personal/civil rights be not violated by them.

Precisely, in the context of aforesaid relief, petitioners have approached the Superintendent of Police, District Patiala, Punjab by way of representation dated 02.06.2020.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State-respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, without meaning anything in the context of validity of marriage and majority of the petitioners, it would be just and appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioners and pass an appropriate order on merits in accordance with law. Respondent No.2 would pass necessary order without being influenced by any pleadings made in the petition.

This order shall not debar the official respondents from proceeding against any of the parties, if they are involved in any other case. It would be appreciated if the needful is done within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
