2. The Petitioner was arrested on 12.02.2020 on the basis of the Disclosure Statement of co-accused Amandeep Singh.
3. He was not named as a Culprit in the original FIR.
4. No recovery till date has been effected from the present Petitioner.
5. In the circumstances, and without commenting upon the other merits of the case, at this stage, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the Petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
