The petition has been taken for hearing through video conference due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Application is allowed as prayed for.

Main Case

In the present writ petition, the petitioner is claiming that the petitioner had appeared in the Patwar Training Examination at Hisar, in December, 1999.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the said examination, the petitioner could not clear the paper No.R-VII and he again appeared in the said examination in March, 2001 but the result of the said examination, has not been declared so far. Prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents for declaring the result of the examination, which the petitioner undertook in March, 2001.

It is very surprising that the petitioner is approaching this Court in the year 2020 for the declaration of the result of an examination, which he undertook in the year 2001.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the issue of the declaration of the result of the examination undertaken by the petitioner in March, 2001, was taken up with the competent authority by the Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estate Department, Haryana, Panchkula, in the year 2014, vide letter dated 10.07.2014 (Annexure P-6) requesting the concerned authority to provide information as to whether, the result of the examination, which the petitioner undertook in March, 2001, in respect of paper R-VII has been declared or not. As no reply to the said letter was received, the said authority wrote an another letter dated 04.09.2019 (Annexure P-4) requesting for the information as to whether the petitioner has passed the said examination or not.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that no response has been received from the Director, Land Records, Haryana, Panchkula, which act is causing prejudice to the petitioner as the services of the petitioner have not been regularized due to non clearance of the Patwar Training Examination.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana-respondents and submits that the appropriate order will be passed on the letter written by the Land Acquisition Collector, Urban Estate Department, Haryana, Panchkula, to the Director Land Records dated 04.09.2019 (Annexure P-4) within a period of six weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the State, as recorded above, the grievance of the petitioner stands satisfied and the petitioner does not press this writ petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.

However, it is made clear that the undertaking recorded above on behalf of the State, be complied with positively.
