The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned State counsel submits that the statements of the petitioners have been recorded that they are not receiving any threat to their life and liberty and are staying together peacefully.

No body is present on behalf of the petitioners so as to controvert the position apprised by the learned State counsel. Even otherwise, process fee has not been filed.

Since the petitioners are statedly staying together and there is no threat to their life and liberty, the present petition stands disposed of accordingly.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are liberty to approach the SSP concerned.
