The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

CRM-W-322-2020

Prayer in this application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for exemption from filing signed power of attorney of the petitioner in original, affidavit and affixing of court fee.

Prayer for exemption of court fee on account of COVID-19 is accepted with the condition that the petitioners shall deposit the required court fee/documents within a period of one month when the situation becomes normal from the COVID-19 effect.

Application stands disposed of accordingly.

CRWP-3461-2020

Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.2

and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However, the private respondents are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they have moved a representation dated 02.06.2020(Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Without going into the validity of the marriage of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 –Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa to take appropriate remedial measures on the representation dated 02.06.2020 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners as warranted by law.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.
