The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.37 dated 21.02.2020, registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 306 read with Section 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for almost 08 months. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, as charges have not yet been framed. There is no

other criminal case pending against the petitioner. Thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel concedes that the charges have not yet been framed and that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has undergone almost 08 months of custody and the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
