This Civil Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order Memo No.ePDS-2020/7890 dated 20.05.2020 (Annexure P/4) passed by respondent No.2 vide which respondent-State has ordered to supply essential commodities in State of Haryana only after bio-metric authentication of beneficiaries.

Learned counsel for petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated 26.05.2020 to concerned authorities, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/5, but still no action has been taken.
