[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 03.04.2020, on the disclosure statement made by the co-accused persons, who were actually apprehended with the contraband.

[3]. No recovery of any contraband has ever been directly effected from the petitioner.

[4]. In such circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned, with a further direction that he shall report at his Local Police Station twice a week till completion of the investigation.
