By this order, three criminal petitions i.e CRM-M-14310-2020, CRM-M-16553-2020 and CRM-M-16636-2020 shall stand disposed of.

The petitioners are accused in G.D. no.4 dated 9.5.2020 under Section 323, 324, 506, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC

(added lateron) at Police Station Boha, District Mansa in FIR No. 50 dated 8.5.2020 registered under Section 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

On 10.7.2020, in CRM-M-16553-2020 titled as 'Gurpreet Singh and another vs. State of Punjab', the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in a cross case registered vide G.D. no.4 dated 9.5.2020 under Section 323, 324, 506, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added lateron) at Police Station Boha, District Mansa in FIR No. 50 dated 8.5.2020 registered under Section 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

The petitioner no.1 had got registered the FIR No. 50 dated 8.5.2020 under Section 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC as noticed above. The petitioners are accused in cross version which has been registered vide G.D no.4 dated 9.5.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is a case of version and cross version. The petitioners have been attributed injuries which are simple in nature. He further submits that accused belonging to other party have been granted bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

In view of the above, adjourned to
21.7.2020.

List alongwith CRM-M-14310-2020 on
the date fixed.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, this
Court is of the considered view that let the petitioners
join investigation.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest,
the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject
to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the
satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.
However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as
and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the
conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupinder
Singh has submitted that all the petitioners (in all three cases) who are
total five in number have joined the investigation, cooperated and are not
required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, orders dated 19.6.2020 (passed in
CRM-M-14310-2020), 10.7.2020 (passed in CRM-M-16553-2020) and
10.7.2020 (passed in CRM-M-16636-2020) are hereby made absolute.

Petitions stand allowed.
