The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.24, dated 27.02.2020, under Sections 307, 326, 451, 427, 120, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

[2]. Contends *inter alia* that the petitioner has remained in detention since 11.04.2020. He was not named in the original FIR. Subsequently, the complainant gave a supplementary statement on the basis of which, involvement of the petitioner was apparently determined by the Authorities. Further submits that Vijay Kumar the only accused person, specifically named in the case, has already been granted bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 07.05.2020 in CRM-M-12038-2020.

Ld. State Counsel does not dispute the above facts.

[4]. In the given circumstances, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period at this stage is not warranted and he is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
