The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.283, dated 29.04.2020, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

In a nutshell, the case of the prosecution is that Amit Kumar alias Sonu alias Chidia son of Mani Ram was apprehended with 10 gram heroin. During interrogation, he disclosed to have purchased the recovered contraband from Sushil Bhura resident of Kirti Nagar. The petitioner, namely, Bhura Singh has filed the present petition claiming that he is son of Amarjit Singh, resident of Gali Depot Wali, M.C. Colony, Sirsa. He is a different person, hence, sought to be falsely implicated.

Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

A detailed reply has been filed by Deputy Inspector General-

cum-Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, in deference to the order dated 11.06.2020. The confusion with regard to involvement of the petitioner has been explained in paragraph 3 of the affidavit. It has also been brought to the notice of the court that the petitioner was in regular contact with Amit. Sister of the petitioner is married to Satnam Singh, who is at present in Central Jail, Hisar. The petitioner himself was/is also involved in 14 other criminal cases.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, this court is not inclined to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
