Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.86 dated 06.04.2020 under Sections 147, 149, 188, 323 IPC and Section 307 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Sirsa Sadar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a lady aged about 24 years, carrying four and half months pregnancy. It is further submitted that initially the FIR was registered under Sections 147, 149, 188, 323 IPC and Section 307 IPC was added later on. It is also submitted that a perusal of the FIR shows that though the petitioner is named in the FIR, however, no specific allegations are against her and even the injury invoking Section 307 IPC is attributed to co-accused Ramesh Kumar and Bhagwan Singh.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position as well

as role of the petitioner. It is also not disputed that the petitioner is carrying four and half months pregnancy.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing her bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
