The present order shall dispose of two petitions i.e. Crl. Misc. M-14429 and 3315 of 2020 whereby, the petitioners seek regular bail in a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 235 dated 20.10.2019 under Sections 420, 379 IPC, P.S. City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

In Crl. Misc. M-3315 of 2020, on 03.03.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per the affidavit, which has been filed by the State, out of the five cases against the petitioner, he has been acquitted in three cases and in rest of two cases he has already been granted the concession of bail. He has stated that it is only because of those cases, the petitioner has been roped up in the present case. He

undertakes to join the investigation as and when required by the police and to fully cooperate in the investigation process and therefore there should not be any need of custodial interrogation.

Adjourned to 08.05.2020.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 06.3.2020 at 10:00 AM to join the investigation and fully cooperate in the investigation process and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”

In Crl. Misc. M-14429 of 2020, on 07.07.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Counsel points out that the anticipatory bail application of the co accused Parkash Chand bearing Crl. Misc. M-3315 of 2020 is pending for 25.08.2020 and interim relief has been granted in the said case. It is further pointed that the the petitioner has already been released on anticipatory bail in FIR No. 180 by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in February, 2020.

Notice of motion.

Mr. H.S. Sullar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice.

Adjourned to 25.08.2020.

To be heard alongwith Crl. Misc. M-3315 of 2020.

In the meantime, it is directed that the petitioner shall join investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad-interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the investigation officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when required and shall comply with the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioners in both the cases have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation, which fact has been vouched for by counsel the State, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh.

Accordingly, order dated 07.07.2020 in Crl. Misc. M-14429 of 2020 and order dated 03.03.2020 in Crl. Misc. M-3315 of 2020 are confirmed and the petitions stand disposed of.
