Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents to call the petitioner for scrutiny of the documents and to take the interview/viva-voce, scheduled to be held w.e.f. 15.06.2020 to 19.06.2020 for the post of Staff Nurse.

At the outset, it is contended by learned Counsel for the petitioner that his client would be satisfied in case her representation dated 02.06.2020 (P-11), addressed to the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula is decided expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

Mr. D.S.Nalwa, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Since the prayer is innocuous and learned State Counsel has also fairly stated that the representation in question shall be considered and decided according to law expeditiously and preferably within two weeks.

Disposed off accordingly.

However, it is clarified that in case some adverse decision is taken against the petitioner, she would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law including before this Court.
