The matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members and for unlocking their house.

In the reply, it is asserted that the police party never conducted any raid at the house of the petitioners nor the house was ever sealed or any harassment to the petitioners was caused.

The learned counsel for the petitioners expresses satisfaction with the explanation of the State.

In this view of the matter, the Court feels that the intended purpose of filing the instant petition is fully achieved.
