The petition has been taken for hearing through video conference due to Covid-19 pandemic.

In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioners is that an appropriate direction be issued to respondents No.1 to 5 for restoration of water supply connection to the house of the petitioners as the same has been illegally disconnected.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that on the pretext of repairing the water supply pipeline, the water supply connection leading to the house of the petitioners was disconnected and the same is not being restored without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have already approached the competent authorities for the redressal of their grievance, which can be seen from the representations attached with the present petition as Annexures P/4 to P/7.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Monica Chhibber Sharma, Senior DAG, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the

service of advance copy of petition accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab.

Learned State counsel submits that keeping in view the instructions, which she has received from Mr. Pradeep Kumar, SDO, Water Supply, Nawanshahar, the water supply connection will be restored to the house of the petitioners within a period of seven days under all circumstances without any failure.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel with regard to restoration of water supply of their house within a period of seven days from today, the grievance of the petitioners stands redressed and he does not want to press the present writ petition any further and the same may be disposed of as having been not pressed.

Ordered accordingly.

However, it is made clear that statement made on behalf of respondent-State, as recorded above, be complied with in its letter and spirit.
