The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.0041 dated 16.03.2020, under Sections 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station 31, Chandigarh.

[2]. Reply of the U.T.Chandigarh by way of an Affidavit of the Inspector, Crime Branch, Sector-11, Chandigarh, has been sent up through e-mail; Be taken on record.

[3]. The petitioner, who is a woman, was arrested on 16.03.2020 and has since then remained in detention.

[4]. After completion of investigation, challan has already been submitted, although, the FSL report, regarding chemical examination of the contraband allegedly recovered from her, has not yet been received.

[5]. The alleged recovery from the petitioner was of 101 grams of Heroin, which is below the commercial quantity, and there is no record of the petitioner qua her involvement in any other case under NDPS Act.

[6]. For the aforesaid reasons, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified and the petitioner, who is woman and, under custody since 15.03.2020, at this stage, she is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
