ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Petitioners pray for a direction to the official respondents i.e. respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their lives and personal liberty as also to respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in their personal lives.

Both the petitioners claim themselves to be major and have been in a live-in relationship for quite some time. And being consenting adults they have decided to live together under one roof. But as the private respondents are of orthodox mind set and temperament they have not been able to reconcile or approve their relationship. Rather they have threatened the petitioners with dire consequences. And are pressurizing petitioner No.1 to marry someone of their choice. Faced with this situation, the petitioners had even represented to respondent no.2 vide representation dated 4.6.2020

Given the nature of the limited issue involved and the order I propose to pass, neither any formal notice to the respondents nor their response would be necessary at this stage.

Thus, in the wake of the above, and without commenting upon the veracity of the allegations/assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa (respondent No.2), that, if any such representation, as indicated above, is pending, the same shall be considered forthwith and appropriate measures, as deemed necessary, shall be taken.

A copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
