CRM-W-345-2020

Allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions.

CRWP-3557-2020

A mandamus is prayed for commanding the official respondents
(respondents No.1 to 3) to protect the lives and personal liberty of the
petitioners.

Both the petitioners claim themselves to be major as petitioner
No.1 is 32 years old and petitioner No.2 is 38 years of age. Concededly,
petitioner No.1 is married to respondent No.4 but since 2014 she has been
living separately owing to her differences with her husband-Jasbir son of
Tulsi. Likewise, petitioner No.2 was married to one Sapna but the said
marriage has since been dissolved. The petitioners who claim to know each

other for the past 5 years are in live in relationship for the last 2-3 months. It is alleged that respondents No.4 to 7 upon knowing that petitioners are living together have threatened them with dire consequences and that they will be eliminated. Faced with this situation they had represented to Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh (respondent no.2) vide representation dated 17.5.2020 (Annexure P-3) for protection of their lives, but to no avail.

Given the nature of the limited issue involved and the order I propose to pass, neither any formal notice to the respondents nor their response would be necessary at this stage.

Thus, in the wake of the above, and without commenting upon the veracity of the allegations set out in the petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh (respondent No.2), that, if any such representation, as indicated above, is pending, the same shall be considered forthwith and appropriate measures, in accordance with law, shall be taken.

A copy of this order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
