Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.115 dated 12.10.2019, registered under Sections 302, 364, 506 IPC, at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

According to prosecution, petitioner administering/injecting some poisonous substance, murdered his wife Pooja.

Learned counsel *inter alia* contends that wife of petitioner died at his paternal home. The divorce proceedings were going on between the parties pending, but now have rendered infructuous on account of death of the wife of petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for complainant vehemently opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Heard.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, no ground is made out to grant the benefit of regular bail to petitioner.

Dismissed.
