Case taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C the petitioner seeks for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.25 dated 08.03.2020 registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short-the NDPS Act) at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

The case of the prosecution is that on 08.03.2020 after receiving secret information the police raided the house of the petitioner and recovered 13000 intoxicating tablets. However, the petitioner ran away from the spot.

In view of the above huge recovery of intoxicating tablets from the house of the petitioner; the conduct of the petitioner of fleeing away from the spot; the petitioner having been convicted in another case under the

NDPS Act being FIR No.106 dated 14.08. 2013 registered at Police Station Passiana as also being accused in FIR No.222 of 2020 dated 18.06.2020 registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, in the present case custodial interrogation of the petitioner is considered necessary. Accordingly, this petition is not considered a fit one for the grant of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
