The petitioner has prayed for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.274, dated 31.10.2018 registered under Sections 323, 302, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Patiala.

Status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Yogesh Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-1, Patiala, District Patiala has been placed on record.

The report indicates that petitioner is suffering from fits and is facing serious medical ailments, though treatment is being provided to him. Annexure R-5/T also indicates that petitioner had also been making suicidal attempts. It has also been pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner that if the petitioner gets the treatment by staying with his family members for some period of time, it may prove to be beneficial for him.

In these set of circumstances, without making any expression of opinion on the merits of the case, it is ordered that the petitioner be

released on interim bail for a period of two months subject to his furnishing

requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The petition is allowed. It is further directed that petitioner will surrender on or before 10.9.2020.
