Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.390 dated 27.08.2019, registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, under Section 420 IPC.

A Coordinate Bench, on 15.06.2020, passed the following order:

“Petitioner-Vinod @ Kala has filed the present petition inter alia with a prayer to grant him anticipatory bail in case FIR No.390, dated 27.08.2019 under Section 420 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner based on pleading submits that the main two accused, namely, Bindya and Jitender Kumar have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail. He submits that order dated 30.12.2019 passed in the case of Jitender Kumar has been appended as

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Annexure P-3 with CRM No.13238 of 2020.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sukhdeep Parmar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. He submits that two persons were found cheating in the clerical exam held in Bhagwan Parshuram College, Kurukshetra. He further submits that Jitender Kumar was using mobile phone and when he joined investigation, he named that on the other side of the phone, Vinod @ Kala-petitioner (herein) was helping him.

Adjourned to 17.07.2020.

Interim directions in the same terms as issued in CRM-M No.55680 of 2019 (Annexure P-3).

To be heard along with CRM-M No. 55680 of 2019 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 15.06.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Parkash, submits that the petitioner joined the investigation on 24.06.2020 and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 15.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
