Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail in case FIR No.12 dated 18.01.2020 registered under Sections 21, 25 & 29 of N.D.P.S Act at Police Station, S.T.F, S.A.S Nagar, Mohali.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version an alleged recovery of 270 grams heroin is stated to have been effected in the present case. Even as per prosecution version such recovery has been made from the conscious possession of co-accused namely Pardeep, who was pillion riding on the motorcycle that the petitioner was driving. The alleged recovery has been effected from a cloth which was wrapped around the waist of the co-accused Pardeep.

Petitioner was arrested on 18.1.2020 itself.

Challan in the present case was presented on 8.6.2020 after completion of investigation.

Petitioner concededly is not involved in any other case under the N.D.P.S Act.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
