The case has been taken up by way of Video Conference as per instructions in view of COVID-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel for petitioners prays for withdrawal of petition qua petitioner No. 2.

In view of above, petition qua petitioner No. 2 is dismissed as withdrawn.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in case FIR No. 19, dated 18.2.2020, registered under Sections 324, 323, 341, 427, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar.

The case has been registered on the statement of one Onkar Singh as per which on 17.2.2020 at about 5.30 PM when he was returning to his house after work, then Tirath Ram and his wife Dimple alongwith some unknown persons armed with weapons came and brutally assaulted him.

Learned counsel for petitioner contends that petitioner No. 1 was not named in the FIR. No specific injury has been attributed to him. He is in custody since 7.3.2020. Investigation in this case is complete and challan has been presented.

Without commenting anything on merit of case and also bearing in mind the fact that petitioner is in custody since 7.3.2020 and the trial of the case may take a long time, this petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
