Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.62 dated 15.03.2020 under Sections 323, 452 and 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC (Sections 308 and 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar.

A Coordinate Bench, on 09.06.2020, passed the following order:

“Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to petitioner in case FIR No.62 dated 15.03.2020 under Sections 323, 452 and 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC (Sections 308 and 325 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that only fist blows on the person of injured-Shyam Lal have been attributed to petitioner, whereas grievous injuries and that too with iron rod on the person of injured-Shyam Lal have been attributed to co-accused Manmohan Singh alias Mohan. He further submits that injured-Shyam Lal has already been discharged from the hospital. He further urges that petitioner is ready to join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and seeks time to file detailed reply. Complete copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 20.08.2020.

Meanwhile, in the eventuality of arrest of petitioner in the instant case FIR, he shall be enlarged on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. Petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by Investigating Agency. Petitioner shall abide by conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit. However, petitioner has been given liberty to defer the furnishing of surety bond due to COVID-19 but he is directed to furnish the surety bond on culmination of nationwide lockdown due to COVID-19.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 09.06.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Charanjeet Singh, submits that the petitioner joined the investigation on 22.06.2020 and

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is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
