Learned counsel appearing for the complainant does not dispute that the matter has been amicably settled and states that he has no objection in case the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail. He has also filed affidavit to the said extent.

In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to join the investigation and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

In case, the petitioner does not join the investigation or does not cooperate in the investigation, the respondent/State shall be at liberty to file an application for cancellation of his anticipatory bail.
