This application is ordered, granting time for compliance with all legal requirements. Subject to such compliance a copy of the final order passed in this case shall be furnished.

The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No.122 dated 07.05.2020 on the file of Police Station Pinangwan, District Nuh, registered under Sections 392, 506 and 188 IPC and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act, 1959. By way of this petition, he seeks grant of regular bail.

The Deputy Superintendent of Police, Pinangwan, District Nuh, filed a reply, on behalf of the State, opposing this bail petition. Therein, he stated that the petitioner along with the two other accused were arrested on

vehicle, which had been looted, was recovered. He conceded that 13 cases were registered against one of the co-accused but this was the only case registered against the petitioner. It appears that the other co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted bail. That being so, the petitioner would also be entitled to relief, subject to conditions.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioner on bail in FIR No.122 dated 07.05.2020 on the file of Police Station Pinangwan, District Nuh, upon his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.50,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Duty/Illaqa Magistrate concerned. Further, the petitioner shall not cause any inducement, threat or promise to any person involved with this case.
