These petitions have been taken for hearing through video conference due to Covid-19 pandemic.

**CM Nos.5150-CWP to 5153-CWP of 2020**

Applications are allowed as prayed for.

**Main Case**

By this common order, all the aforesaid writ petitions, details of which have been given in the heading of this order, are being decided as all the writ petitions involve the same question of law as well as similar facts. For the purpose of the present order, the facts are being taken from CWP No.7919 of 2020 titled as ***“Ritu Rani v State of Haryana and others”***.

The challenge in the aforesaid writ petitions is the to the Notification dated 21.05.2020 (Annexure P-5) issued by the Kurukshetra University for holding the semester examinations from 01.07.2020 onwards.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioners be allowed to withdraw the aforesaid writ petitions at this stage with liberty to approach the respective Universities as well as the Department of Education, Government of Haryana, for the redressal of their grievance as raised in the aforesaid writ petitions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as only three weeks are left for the commencement of the examination as notified by the impugned Notification dated 21.05.2020 (Annexure P-5), a direction be issued to the concerned University as well as to the Education Department, Government of Haryana, for deciding the representation(s) of the petitioner (s) which they will submit to the authority concerned in a time bound manner by passing appropriate speaking order, in respect of the grievance raised therein.

Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana states that in case, the petitioner(s) approach the Government of Haryana or the concerned University in respect of their grievance as raised in the aforesaid

writ petitions qua Notification dated 21.05.2020 (Annexure P-5), by filing any representation, the same will be disposed of within a period of seven days from the receipt of the same by passing appropriate speaking order and the speaking order so passed will be conveyed to the representationists on their address given in the representation(s).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is satisfied by the undertaking given by the learned State counsel and therefore, he be allowed to withdraw the aforesaid writ petitions to approach the Department of Education, Government of Haryana and the concerned University raising the grievance as raised in the aforesaid writ petitions.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.

It is made clear that the State of Haryana and the Universities will be bound by the statement made by learned State counsel for disposing of the representation, if any received from the petitioner(s), within a period of seven days from the receipt of the same. It is also made clear that this Court expresses no opinion on the merits of the claim being made by the petitioner(s) in the aforesaid writ petitions or in the representation(s) which will be submitted to the authorities hereinafter.
