By way of instant writ petition, the petitioners are seeking the same pay scale as has been allowed to Clerks/Restorers working on the establishment of the Civil Secretariat Punjab, Chandigarh and Punjab and Haryana High Court at Chandigarh along with arrears of pay and interest.

The petitioners herein are working in the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, and seek the same pay scale on the post of Restorers, as has been allowed to the similarly situated persons who have been allowed pay scale in CWP No.18466 of 2014 and CWP No.4456 of 2016.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Mr. Pankaj Gupta, Addl. AG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and very fairly states that the claim of the petitioners herein would be considered in the light of the judgments that have been passed by this court.

In view of the very fair statement made, the instant writ petition is being disposed of, giving a direction to the respondent-State to consider the case of the petitioner for equal pay scale by passing a speaking order in terms of the judgments passed by this Court within a period of two months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
