This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with several prayers, one of them being to initiate a departmental enquiry against respondent No.4, who while being in Punjab police is alleged to have committed an offence of moral turpitude and an FIR under Sections 376, 506 of Indian Penal Code has been registered.

Notice of motion was issued in the matter, pursuant to which a status report has been filed, which is taken on record.

As per the status report filed by the respondent-State, departmental proceedings have already been initiated against respondent No.4-accused and after completing the investigation, a challan has already been presented in the court on 28.07.2020. It is also submitted that

respondent No.4-accused has already been directed to join the investigation by this court in his bail application.

In view of the above, since departmental proceedings have already been initiated against respondent No.4 and after completing the investigation, a challan has already been presented in the court, no further orders are called for in the instant writ petition.
