Main case

**Counsel for respondents No.3 and 4 would inform that
petitioner has already been reverted to his parent department and posted
there. He would further inform that whatever was due to be paid by
respondents No.3 and 4, the same has already been paid. However, he
would submit that the present petition may be disposed of and the petitioner
may point it out to respondents No.3 and 4 if anything more is due to be
paid by them and a decision in that regard would be taken expeditiously.**

Counsel for the petitioner, in response, would state that the petition may be disposed of but without prejudice to right of the petitioner to make a representation to respondents No.3 and 4 with regard to his outstanding dues and the same may be decided by the Competent Authority in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of. In case the petitioner makes a representation with regard to outstanding dues, if any, within a period of one month, the same shall be decided by the authority concerned of Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, within a period of one month from the date of its receipt, in accordance with law.
