The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.86, dated 6.5.2020 under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 25.6.2020 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel has apprised this Court that the FSL report has since been received and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C would be presented before the Special Court in the near future. She, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh has not been able to controvert the fact that the recovery of 5 grams of heroine so effected from the petitioner falls in the category of 'small quantity'. On a query put to her, she has informed the Court that the petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 25.6.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
