SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.49, dated 17.05.2019 registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 506, 34 of IPC and Sections 326, 307 of IPC added later on, at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged occurrence is of 15.05.2020 whereas the FIR was lodged two days later i.e. on 17.05.2020. He further argues that no injury is attributed to the petitioner. Injury attracting Section 307, IPC is attributed to co-accused Jagdeep Singh. His contention is that now the parties have entered into compromise on 16.06.2020. Copy of which has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel upon instructions of ASI Gurmail Singh has verified the factum of compromise between the parties.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the parties have compromised the matter and conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in further detention. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, Gurdeep Singh, is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
