This petition has been filed for setting aside the order dated 09.12.2019 passed by the Commissioner, Hisar Division denying grant of parole to the petitioner for a period of three weeks to enable him to meet with his family members and for restoring social ties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has maintained good conduct in jail and has been regularly appearing before the trial Court during the trial and whenever he comes out on parole.

Learned Additional Advocate General is not in a position to deny this fact.

In these circumstances, we see no good reason to deny the petitioner the benefit of parole for three weeks.

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Consequently, the petition stands allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on parole for a period of three weeks subject to satisfaction of the jail authorities. On the expiry of period of parole of three weeks, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the jail authorities. However, the parole shall be subject to the following terms and conditions :-

- i. The petitioner shall furnish a telephone number to the Jail Superintendent on which he can be contacted, if required. After his release, he shall also inform his telephone number to the SHO of the police station concerned.
- ii. The petitioner shall keep away from the area around the residence of the victim and his/her family members.
- iii. Immediately upon the expiry of period of parole, the petitioner shall surrender himself before the Jail Superintendent.
- iv. The period of parole shall be counted from the date after the date when the petitioner is released from jail.

Since the main case has been allowed, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
