Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.202 dated 07.05.2020, registered at Police Station Gannaur, District Sonipat, under Sections 323, 354-B, 506 and 34 IPC.

A Coordinate Bench, on 11.06.2020, passed the following order:

“Inter alia contends that custodial interrogation is not necessary as no recovery is to be effected.

Notice of motion for 20.08.2020.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 23.06.2020 at 10.00 a.m. and cooperate therewith. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to his compliance of the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 11.06.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sudesh, submits that the petitioner joined the investigation on 17.06.2020 and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
