Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.93 dated 10.05.2020, registered at Police Station Dina Nagar, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, Section 13 of the Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012 and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional (Regulation) Act, 2014.

A Coordinate Bench, on 11.06.2020, passed the following order:

“Inter alia submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. The story given in the FIR is palpably incorrect because the son of the complainant namely Tarlochan Singh is working in Kuwait and if the grandson of the complainant had to

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go to Kuwait he would stay with his father. There was no necessity of him seeking refuge with the husband of the petitioner. In fact, the husband of the petitioner had given Kuwaiti currency to the son of the complainant in lieu of which the complainant gave Indian currency to the petitioner.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 23.06.2020 at 10.00 a.m. and cooperate therewith. In the event of her arrest, she shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to her compliance of the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 11.06.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, submits that the petitioner joined the investigation on 23.06.2020 and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
