The petitioner is the accused in FIR No. 21 dated 10.2.2020 on the file of Police Station-Women, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar, registered under Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, along with Sections 323 and 506 IPC. By way of the present petition, he seeks grant of regular bail.

The case of the petitioner is that he has a relationship with the victim girl and is desirous of marrying her. However, her family members were not agreeable and this led to the registration of the case against him.

Mr. Manoj Pundir, learned counsel for the petitioner, stated that a compromise was effected between the parties on 2.6.2020 which was reduced to writing and in consequence thereof, the mother of the victim girl, who was the complainant, furnished an affidavit stating that she did not want to pursue the case.

Ms. Savita Rana, learned counsel, informed the Court that she has been instructed to appear on behalf of the complainant, the mother of the victim girl. She states that she has no objection to grant of regular bail to the petitioner as the complainant wants to get her daughter married to the petitioner eventually, as desired by them.

Given the aforesaid circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that the interests of justice would be better served by permitting the parties to amicably settle the issue and at this stage, the continued incarceration of the the petitioner would not be desirable.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioner on regular bail in FIR No. 21 dated 10.2.2020 on the file of Police Station-Women, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar, upon his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate concerned.
