On 10.06.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 71 dated 20.5.2020 registered under Section 498- A (wrongly mentioned in FIR as Section 498 of IPC), 323 IPC at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

The FIR is result of matrimonial discord between the son of the petitioners and the first informant. There are general allegations of having beaten the first informant against the petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the first informant and son of the petitioners are living independently and the first informant has falsely implicated all the members of the family of her in-laws.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. S.P.S.Tinna, Addl.AG,

Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to seek instructions.

Mr. Gurwinder Singh Sidhu, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the first informant.

Adjourned to 16.6.2020.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh, submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation, at this stage.

In view thereof, order dated 10.06.2020 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
