The first petitioner is the husband of the deceased while the second petitioner is her mother-in-law. They are the accused in FIR No. 0558 dated 26.11.2019 on the file of Police Station Thanesar Sadar, District Kurukshetra, registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC. By way of the present petition, they seek grant of regular bail.

The deceased is stated to have committed suicide by consuming poison. Initially, the offence alleged against the petitioners was one under Section 302 IPC but after due investigation, the same was converted to one under Section 306 IPC. It appears that the complainant, the father of the deceased, is no longer desirous of pursuing the case and deposed to an affidavit on 18.5.2020 stating to that effect.

In these circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served by the continued incarceration of the petitioners at this stage. The petitioners would therefore be entitled to grant of bail subject to conditions.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioners on regular bail in FIR No. 0558 dated 26.11.2019 on the file of Police Station Thanesar Sadar, District Kurukshetra, upon their furnishing personal bonds for a sum of Rs. 20,000/- each along with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate concerned. Further, the petitioners shall not cause any threat, inducement or promise to any person involved with the case.
