Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.34 dated 22.05.2020, registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act and Section 24 of the Immigration Act.

A Coordinate Bench, on 25.06.2020, passed the following order:

*“Case taken up through video conferencing.*

*Notice of motion.*

*Mr. Gaurav Garg Dhuriwala, Addl. AG, Punjab  
accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.*

*For arguments, adjourned to 20.08.2020.*

*In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.0034 dated 22.05.2020 registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act and Section 24 of Immigration Act registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”*

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 25.06.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bikramjeet Singh, submits that the the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 25.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
