On 10.6.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.50 dated 25.03.2020 registered under Sections 420/120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

In a nutshell, the case of the prosecution is that late Sh. Gurmail Singh and Bhola Singh got mutated the land in their name after the death of late Sh. Baru Singh, on the basis of a Will. Gurmail Singh died and the petitioner being one of the natural heir succeeded to the property alongwith two others. Thereafter, the petitioner transferred the property in favour of her two brothers. Now, the first informant is disputing the correctness of the mutation sanctioned in

favour of Gurmail Singh in the year 2009.

Adjourned to 18.06.2020.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Havaldar Bhupinder Singh submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 10.6.2020 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
