On 10.6.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.140, dated 08.05.2020, registered under Sections 148/149/188/323/452/506 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh.

In a nutshell, the case of the prosecution is that a quarrel between two groups from a trivial matter. Both the groups had put their nets for catching fishes from the canal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that all the petitioners i.e. 5 in number, have been attributed simple injuries and they do not have criminal antecedents.

Notice of motion for 16.06.2020.

On asking of this court, Mr. Deepak Sabharwal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that he does not dispute the aforesaid position.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is directed that the petitioners would join the investigation as and when called upon by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 10.6.2020 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
