GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Suresh Kumar has filed the present petition *inter alia* praying for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.41 dated 19.02.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station City Ratia, District Fatehabad.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact, the allegations in the FIR are civil in nature. He submits that civil dispute is pending between the parties. Learned counsel further submits that the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement but because of COVID-19 situation, he could not place the same on record.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sukhdeep Parmar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Mr. Dhananjay Mittal, Advocate, appears for the complainant.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the fact regarding reaching out the settlement.

In view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case as noticed above, the parties are expected to honour the settlement.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one in case the necessity arose.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
