Prima facie, this Court is unable to comprehend as to how the petitioner has arrived at the conclusion that there is an apprehension of his arrest. Neither any FIR has been appended with the petition nor even otherwise pleaded that there has been registration of any FIR against any person connected with the petitioner. Merely a bald assertion has been made that respondent No.5, who is a business rival of the petitioner, has submitted some false complaints to the police officials.

Be that as it may, no case is made out to establish any apprehension of arrest to invoke section 438 of Cr.P.C. Petitioner is at liberty to re-approach this Court in the event it turns out later, depending upon subsequent developments, if any, that may give rise to any such apprehension.
