The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

The petitioner Kuldeep Singh aged 48 years has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the respondents to take legal action in accordance with law on his complaint dated 12.05.2020 (P4) against Dharminder Singh, Gurvinder Singh sons of Sh. Kamaljit Singh r/o H.No.22, Village Mataur, PS Mataur, Tehsil and District SAS Nagar Mohali.

Record shows that on 10.06.2020, notice of motion was issued and the State was asked to file reply.

Today, reply has been shared through internet on whatsapp group of the administrator who is conducting the video conferencing. State counsel is directed to file reply in the Registry.

In the reply filed by way of affidavit of Gursher Singh Sandhu, PPS, DSP City-I, District SAS Nagar, it has been stated that the petition has become infructuous. Learned State counsel by making reference to paras 7 & 9 submits that the action has been taken. Annexures in support have also been appended along with the reply.

In view of the above, since substantial relief has been granted, the petition is disposed of as no further orders are called for.

Accepting the request made by petitioner’s counsel, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail remedy as may be available to him in accordance with law.
