Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.137 dated 10.10.2018 under Sections 307, 34 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year and as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of Gurpreet Singh, he is brother of Room Singh and Ravinder Singh and on 09.10.2018, they were going on a motorcycle, when two persons came from opposite side on a motorcycle. Petitioner Lovepreet Singh was pillion rider. They stopped the motorcycle and Lovepreet Singh started firing from the pistol. Brother of the complainant got injured, as he received two fire shots in the abdomen and fire shot injuries on the right arm. Thereafter, the accused

persons ran away and the victim was taken to the hospital. It is further submitted that without prejudice to his right of defence, the petitioner is ready to deposit a sum of Rs.1.00 lac with the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate to be paid to the victim.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the investigation is complete, however, the charges have not been framed so far. It is not disputed that the petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year and is not involved in any other case except one case under Section 52-A of Prison Act, in which he is on bail.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

This will, however, be subject to the condition that the petitioner will deposit a sum of Rs.1.00 lac with the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, which will be paid to the victim, who has suffered injuries, without prejudice to his right of defence, to be taken during the course of trial.

Petition is disposed of.
