On 11.06.2020 the following order was passed:-

Petitioner-Juganpreet Singh has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to grant him anticipatory bail in case FIR No.5, dated 11.01.2020 under Section 452, 427, 506 of IPC, Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on pleadings has drawn attention of this Court to the contents of the FIR. Therein, the allegation is that Gulab Singh and along with others and the petitioner named therein as Jugnu forcibly entered inside the factory.

Learned counsel submits that the similar petition of Gulab Singh is fixed for 14.07.2020. He submits that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Adjourned to 14.07.2020.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-10806-2020.

Interim directions in the same terms as issued in
CRM-M-10806-2020.

On instructions of SI Amandeep Kaur, Police Station Patran, District Patiala, it has been pointed out by the learned State counsel that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the order dated 13.03.2020, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition is accordingly, allowed.
